AVIATION CAREER TRAINING PROGRAM GROWTH

In 2012, Able Flight continued to expand its Career Training Scholarship program with new three awards. With funding provided from a grant from the TBMOPA Foundation, scholarships were awarded to Kevin Crombie and Wesley Major for their studies at Purdue University's Department of Aviation Technology, and to Jessica Scharle to attend a course to become an FAA-certified Airline Dispatcher.

Crombie is studying for an undergraduate degree in aviation management, while Majors is a student in the graduate program at Purdue. Scharle completed her training and earned her certification and is now a full time employee of an airline.

In 2012, six students attended Able Flight's third annual joint training program at Purdue University. That was an increase of 50% over 2011. A Purdue graduate student instructor was assigned to each student pilot for the duration of their six weeks of intensive flight and ground school training. Students Tyrell Rhodes, Steven Scott, Jason Jernigan, Wesley Majors, Devon Radloff and Matt Sponaugle all completed training, passed their check rides and earned their pilot certificates. This continued Able Flight's 100% success rate for scholarship recipients who have trained at Purdue since the program began there in 2010.


